



April 7 (Holy Tuesday)

Arrival in Thessaloniki

Welcome to Thessaloniki!

You will be met at the airport, on arrival, and transferred to your hotel.

Take the remaining time of the day to discover Thessaloniki! A vibrant city rich with history and mythology, enlivened by bustling outdoor cafes, pedestrian streets that wind through the city's numerous stores and its fair share of urban eccentrics, a city full of contrasts.

Day 2

April 8 (Holy Wednesday)

Thessaloniki city tour. Zoe church.


(Acts 17:1)"Now, when they had passed through Amphipolis and Apollonia, they came to Thessalonica..."

One of the most spiritual churches of the New Testament was in Thessalonica. The tour will start with sightseeing of the city of Thessaloniki. Driving to the old city, we will be able to admire the Byzantine city walls, the white tower, the triumph arch of Galerius and the Rotunda. We will see the Roman forum, the church of St.Demetrius, who is the patron saint of the city and the "Agora", the city square forum which was one of the most important places in the city, during Paul's time, and is mentioned in Acts.

Afterwards, we will visit the museum of Thessaloniki.

Lastly, in the evening we will visit the local church "Zoe church" in Thessaloniki.


(Acts 16:9-11)"Come over into Macedonia and help us..."

The Apostle Paul was praying, asking for the direction of the holy spirit as to which city he should travel to. He arrived in Troas and there he had a dream, sent by the spirit of God. Therefore, his trip to Europe began and the first country he visited was Greece.

He arrived at Neapolis (Modern city of Kavala) which was situated near Philippi. Philippi was named after Phillip II, father of Alexander the Great, and became a very important Roman colony. There, the Ap. Paul established the very first Christian church in Europe.

One of the highlights of the first day of the tour will be our visit to the river of Lydia, otherwise known as the "Jordan river of Greece". At this place, where the Ap. Paul met Lydia and where his so-called prison is situated (Acts 16:40), we will have the possibility of placing a prayer.

Return to Thessaloniki for overnight.



April 10 (Good Friday)

Veroia, Vergina, Kalampaka. Epitaphios at Meteora.


We will depart Thessaloniki and start our tour with visiting the city of ancient Veroia.

Paul the Apostle preached the Gospel, faith, salvation and love to a large number of Jews and Bereans. His preach had a great resonance and since his first visit in the Macedonian town he had proselytized many Verians to the new religion. Paul visited Veroia twice; in 56 AD and at the beginning of 57 AD during his journey from Asia Minor to Greece. Paul's the Apostle passage through Veroia and the impact of his preaching, reveal the significance of the town at the first steps of Christianity and the important role that the town played for the spreading and establishment the Christian faith in Greece. Lastly, we will visit the archaeological museum of Vergina (Royal Tombs). Hundreds of items are displayed including beautiful gold creations, elaborate jewelry, colorful wall paintings, mosaics, hundreds of ancient items and others, used by the royal family. Some of the most spectacular exhibits of the museum are the shield and armor of King Phillip the second and the famous Golden Larnax of the King.

After that, we will continue our journey to Kalampaka.

In the afternoon of this day, we will have the unique opportunity to take part in the Epitaphios procession led by Orthodox monks—an experience that is truly one of a kind. This rare occasion offers every guest, regardless of their faith, a chance to immerse themselves in the spiritual traditions of Greece, and to witness how Greek Orthodoxs honor and celebrate these sacred days with reverence and devotion.

Day 5

Meteora tour. Drive to Varvrona's resort. Resurrection service.

Kalampaka, is at the base of "Meteora". It has been characterized by UNESCO as a "unique phenomenon of cultural heritage". These rocky formations are littered with Byzantine monasteries (14th - 16th century A.D.) Meteora (="suspended in the air") is a landscape of outstanding natural beauty, the second largest monastic and pilgrimage area in Greece after Mount Athos. We will have the opportunity to visit one monastery and enjoy the breathtaking view.

*Dress code: Sleeveless clothing and shorts over the knee for men are prohibited. For ladies' skirts and shawls are available at the entrance in case they don't have such clothing to cover themselves.

After the tour at Meteora, we will depart for the area of Vravrona, located just 40 minutes outside of Athens, by the sea. Here, we will check in at a luxurious 5-star hotel, where we will experience the solemn celebration of the Great Saturday Resurrection service, followed by the joyful Easter celebration the next day.

In the evening, we will once again have the unique opportunity to attend the Resurrection service at a seaside Orthodox church, joining the local Greek community in this sacred celebration. After the service, we will enjoy the traditional Easter dinner, which will be served either before or after the Resurrection service, depending on the schedule, allowing us to fully embrace the festive spirit of the occasion.



Day 6

April 12 (Easter)

Easter Day has arrived! The day will be free for you to enjoy leisurely walks by the sea or relax by the hotel pool. In the afternoon, we will indulge in a traditional Easter meal at the hotel, savoring the flavors of Greek cuisine as part of the festive celebration.

Overnight stay in Vravrona.





Corinth Tour.

We will leave Vravrona for Corinth early in the morning (Acts 18:1-8). Once there, we will begin our tour with the "Canal" and explain, in detail, why Corinth was such a wealthy center in the days of Ap. Paul. We will then see the "Erastus" inscription and talk about its meaning, its background story and its role in the history of Ap. Paul in Corinth (Romans 16:23). Afterwards, we will visit the archaeological site and walk through the Roman forum where the "Bema", otherwise known as the judgment seat of Gallio, is situated. We will talk about head covering, women in the church, and "the fountain of living waters", presenting you with details and little-known facts.

Lastly, we will go to Kechries (Cenchreae), the eastern port of ancient Corinth at the church of which Phoebe was the deaconess (Romans 16:1).


Day 8 April 14

Athens's sightseeing.

(Acts 17:16-34)"Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his spirit was stirred in him, when he saw the city wholly given to idolatry..."

The tour in Athens includes a sightseeing of the city, visiting the house of parliament, the ancient Olympic stadium, the temple of Zeus and the Hellenic Academy. We will then go to the Acropolis hill to visit the Parthenon and the Erechtheion. We will continue to the nearby Ares Rock (Areopagus - Mars Hill) where the Apostle Paul gave his sermon in Acts 17:16-34 and offers a good view of the modern city of Athens, with the possibility of prayer for Greece.


