WHAT IS REQUIRED TO FACILITATE A GROUP?

- > Find a friend to facilitate with you. (We can help you, if needed.)
- Lead a group for 6 weeks.
- Invite people to join your group.

HINTS ON FACILITATING

- Ideally, have someone in the group host your group in their home. This helps others be involved in the process.
- > Food is optional. If your group time is during the "normal" eating hours (7-9 am, noon, 5-7 pm), having a plan for food will be helpful.
- Group tends to last 1.5-2 hours.

SAMPLE DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Session 1: Distractions

Synopsis: It's so easy to start something with gusto and zeal only to be delayed by distractions. Distractions not only hinder our development, but they hijack our ability to be fully present in each moment. This subtle loss of altitude in our attention threatens to diminish our engagement and even threatens to take us out at times. The biggest thing for each of us is to operate on purpose, for a purpose. Distractions come in all shapes and sizes. Some surprise us, while others are expected. Maybe your best next step is to invite God to help you pivot from thinking about what disctracts to thinking about what develops.

Some questions to consider:

- What are the predictable distrations in your life?
- How will you plan for disctractions and keep them from derailing you?
- What have you learned about yourself and God in the midst of your distractions?
