



What We Believe

About the Scriptures: We believe the entire Bible is the inspired Word of God and that men were moved by the Spirit of God to write the very words of Scripture. Therefore, we believe the Bible is without error.

About God: We believe in one God who exists in three distinct persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We believe that Jesus Christ is the second member of the Trinity (the Son of God) who became flesh to reveal God to humanity and to become the Savior of the lost world.

About Life: We believe all followers of Jesus should live for Christ and not for themselves or by themselves. By obedience to the Word of God and daily yielding to the Spirit of God, every believer should mature and be conformed to the image of Christ. We believe this is best lived out in community with others.

About the Church: We believe Jesus Christ is the head of the Church. The Church is the body of Christ made up of all who have trusted, by faith, in Him. The purpose of the Church is to glorify God by loving him and by making Jesus known throughout the world.
